BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR BOONE COUNTY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ADMINISTER SUCH BUDGET AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BOONE COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The following appropriation shall be made from County General Fund No. 1000:

From: 1000-0101-1002: County Clerk's Office; Personal Services; Part-time Salaries \$5,000.00

To: 1000-0101-1005: County Clerk's Office; Personal Services; Salaries, Overtime \$4,625.00

To: 1000-0101-1006: County Clerk's Office; Personal Services; Social Security Matching \$365.00

To: 1000-0101-1010: County Clerk's Office; Personal Services; Workers Compensation \$10.00

(This sum, \$5,000.00, are funds in the County Clerk's budget for part-time salaries, therefore, no new funds are required. Moving these funds will allow compensation to employees in the Clerk's office impacted by the month-long computer outage. All duties of the office were a manual process during the month of November, which caused extra hours of work for employees and delayed the ability to use accrued leave during said time.)

<u>Section 2.</u> If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and sections of the Ordinance, and to such end the provisions and sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance herein enacted is an Appropriation Ordinance and therefore It is effective immediately.
