

ORDINANCE (1) No. 2023 - 22

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE PAYMENTS TO BE MADE TO EXISTING FULL-TIME COUNTY EMPLOYEES THAT ANSWER CORONER CALLS OUTSIDE OF NORMAL WORKING HOURS.

WHEREAS, Daniel Bolen, 911 Supervisor, is a full-time employee for Boone County; and

WHEREAS, Addison McInerney, Boone County Central Dispatcher, is a full-time employee for Boone County Central Dispatch; and

WHEREAS, these employees are also deputy coroner's and the Boone County Coroner may call these two employees on their off hours to answer coroner related calls and handle required reports; and

WHEREAS, these two employees can respond to scenes to recover and release human remains; and

WHEREAS, these employees shall be paid per trip and must be outside of their regular working hours to receive such payments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE THAT SUCH PAYMENTS CAN BE MADE TO EXISTING COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO RESPOND TO THESE CALLS OUTSIDE OF THEIR NORMAL BUSINESS HOURS.
