APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE (3)  
NO. 2022- 14

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A FUND TO BE CALLED THE NEW COURTHOUSE FUND AND AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR BOONE COUNTY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ADMINISTER SUCH BUDGET AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF ARKANSAS:

**Section 1.** It comes before this Court that there is a need to establish a fund on the books to track the revenues, expenditures and/or appropriated transfers of funds for the New Courthouse project. This Court recognizes and affirms the need for such a fund to properly account for and control all such revenues received and expenditures made in compliance with all applicable laws.

**Section 2.** There is hereby created on the books of the Boone County Treasurer and the books of the Boone County Clerk a fund to be known as the "New Courthouse Fund" with a fund number of 4800 as assigned by Arkansas Legislative Audit.

**Section 3.** The following appropriations shall be made from County General Fund No. 1000:

To: 4800-0100-4002: New Courthouse; Capital Outlays; Buildings \$5,500,000.00

(This sum, \$5,500,000.00, is for the total cost to purchase a building with funding not to exceed four million dollars and necessary renovation costs not to exceed one and a half million dollars. Any funds remaining after the project is completed will revert back to the County General Fund.)

**Section 4.** If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and sections of this Ordinance, and to such end the provisions and sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.


**Section 5.** This Ordinance herein enacted is an Appropriation Ordinance and therefore, it is effective immediately.


