BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR BOONE COUNTY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ADMINISTER SUCH BUDGET AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BOONE COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The following appropriation shall be made from County General Fund No. 1000:

From: 1000-0700-3063: Sanitation; Other Services & Charges; Utilities - Waste Disposal	\$4,301.82
To: 2000-0200-1005: County Roads; Personal Services; Overtime & Other Premium Comp.	\$3,455.76
To: 2000-0200-1006: County Roads; Personal Services; Social Security Matching	\$206.64
To: 2000-0200-1007: County Roads; Personal Services; Retirement Matching	\$529.42
To: 2000-0200-1010: County Roads; Personal Services; Workers Compensation	\$110.00

(This sum, \$4,301.82, is the salaries and benefits cost for the road department employees who worked the county clean-up event held on June 25th, 2022, at Methvin Sanitation. These funds were placed into the Sanitation budget with Appropriation Ordinance No. 2022-19 and a portion is now being transferred into the county roads budget to reimburse for the labor cost.)

Section 2. If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and sections of the Ordinance, and to such end the provisions and sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. This Ordinance herein enacted is an Appropriation Ordinance and therefore It is effective immediately.

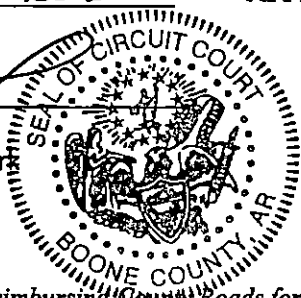
