BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BOONE COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS,  
A RESOLUTION TO BE ENTITLED:

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE OF THE PEACE,  
DISTRICT NO. 5, FOR BOONE COUNTY, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, A condition of vacancy is hereby declared to exist in the office of Justice of the Peace,  
District No. 5, due to the death of Justice Fred Woehl; and

WHEREAS, it is the obligation of the Quorum Court of the County of Boone, State of Arkansas, to  
declare that a vacancy will occur in the office of Justice of the Peace District No. 5 as authorized by  
Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-14-1310; and

WHEREAS, upon declaration of the vacancy by passage of this Resolution, or within 10 calendar days  
after passage of this Resolution, a copy thereof shall be filed with the Governor of the State of Arkansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BOONE COUNTY,  
STATE OF ARKANSAS:

**Section 1.** It is hereby found and determined by the Quorum Court of Boone County that a condition of  
vacancy exists in the office of Justice of the Peace, District No. 5, and that such office is declared to be  
vacant.

**Section 2.** That the County Clerk or County Judge of Boone County is directed to file this declaration of  
vacancy with the Governor.


