ORDINANCE (1)  
ORDINANCE NO. 2018-17

BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE, STATE OF ARKANSAS,  
AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY PERMITTED TO BE CHARGED ON A  
BOONE COUNTY CREDIT CARD OR TO BE REIMBURSED FOR OUT OF TOWN MEALS.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOONE,  
STATE OF ARKANSAS;

SECTION 1. When out of town on Boone County business or training, a Boone County  
employee may be reimbursed or use a Boone County Credit Card for meals with a maximum  
amount to be reimbursed per day being \$50.00 including the tip. Tips are not to exceed 15%.  
There will be no alcoholic beverages charged to the credit card. The employee is responsible  
for any amount exceeding the \$50.00 per day. Receipts are required to be turned in for  
reimbursement.

SECTION 2. If any provision or section of this Ordinance is held invalid by a Court of competent  
jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions and sections of this Ordinance, and  
to such end the provisions and sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance herein enacted is an Ordinance and therefore, it is effective  
immediately.
